TIPS FOR SUCCESSFUL PLANTING WITH BAREROOT FRUIT TREES

- 1 Keep roots moist until planting, covering them with loose soil if necessary.
2. Dig a hole twice as wide and 1 1/2 times deeper than the root mass. Mix the soil with Gardner & Bloome Starter Fertilizer and Gardner & Bloome Planting Mix. Return a few inches of the mixture to the hole.
3. Place the tree in the prepared hole at the correct depth (*see illustration below*). The graft is the swollen part at the bottom of the trunk. The soil should cover the roots but not the graft.
4. Fill in the hole with the soil-fertilizer mixture. The soil should be even with the surrounding soil and **SHOULD NOT BURY THE GRAFT**.
5. Build a 2 inch watering basin around the plant.
6. Water 2-3 times after planting. **RULE OF THUMB:** At each watering a #1 size plant needs 1 gallon of water, a #5 size plant needs 5 gallons of water, etc.
7. A 1 inch mulch with, Gardner & Bloome Soil Building Compost or extra Planting mix, over the soil will keep the root ball cool.
