GUIDE TO SUCCESSFUL PLANTING WITH BIODEGRADABLE POTS

1. Water plants before planting.
2. Dig a hole twice as wide and 1 1/2 times deeper than the container. Mix the soil with Gardner & Bloome Starter Fertilizer and Gardner & Bloome Planting Mix. Return a few inches of the mixture to the hole.
3. Make 3 to 4 slits in the side of the pot beginning half way down the pot and continuing to the bottom. Place the pot at the correct depth. The top of the root ball should be at ground level, slightly visible after planting. You may trim the top edge of the pot down to the top of the root ball if desired. **IMPORTANT: DO NOT REMOVE PLANT FROM CONTAINER**
4. Fill in the hole with the soil-fertilizer mixture.
5. Build a 2 inch watering basin around the plant.
6. Water 2-3 times after planting. **RULE OF THUMB:** At each watering a #1 size plant needs 1 gallon of water, a #5 size plant needs 5 gallons of water, etc.
7. A 1 inch mulch with, Gardner & Bloome Soil Building Compost or extra planting mix, over the soil will keep the root ball cool.
